Skills assessments are coming up on January 13th and 27th, see the next page for full details. 6U/8U players only need to attend if they would like to play up to the next age division. 10U/12U/14U are required to attend one skills assessment in order to be eligible to be drafted to a team.

Draft night for 10U/12U/14U will be on January 31st. Within that next week, you should get a notification through TeamSnap with the team your child was drafted to. Within a week of that notification, you should receive an email from your child's coach welcoming your child to their team and future practice information.

VOLUNTEERS!

Helping hands, help us keep this completely-volunteer-run organization going. Without volunteers there wouldn't be a Northbay Girls Softball League.

Keeping in line with other local youth sports organizations, beginning with this upcoming 2024 season NBGSL will be implementing a mandatory 5 volunteer hours per family (per player) to be completed during the 2024 season to help support our program. If you feel you will be unable to fulfill the 5 volunteer hours per player requirement, during registration you may choose to opt out of volunteering and pay a one-time fee of \$100 per player. 2024 SEASON SKILLS ASSESSMENTS

NBGSL coaches draft teams based on the players' individual skills, with an effort to balance the teams. If your child is playing in 10U/12U/14U, it is **mandatory** for your player to attend one of the two skills assessment dates. If your child is in 6U/8U, they are *only required* to attend one of the below dates *if* they would like to play up to the next age division. *Please note that playing up in any age division is recommended only for skilled players and must be board approved, and is not guaranteed.*

NEEDED FOR ASSESSMENTS:

- Parent/guardian sign in their player, complete waiver
- Parent/guardian confirm jersey size
- Helmet
- Softball glove
- Softball cleats & tennis shoes
- Bat
- Infielders face mask
- Water

IMPORTANT NOTES

- All players arrive *30 minutes prior* to your start time.
- 6U/8U players only need to attend IF they want to play up.
- Pitching assessment required for any girl wanting to pitch 10U/12U/14U.
- Any player wanting to play up WILL ATTEND their regularly assigned age bracket. You are welcome to stay for the following age bracket, the one you would like to play up to, but MUST ATTEND your assigned age bracket skills assessment time.
- Skills assessments will take about 3 hours.

WHERE: Comstock Middle School, basketball courts
TIMES VARY BY AGE:
6U/8U - 9am (Only required if you want to play up to the next age division)
10U - 10:15am
12U - 1:30pm
14U - 4:30pm
