## NBGSL Base Umpire Training Manual

Rev 1.0 - 3/2025

Intent:

- The intent of this document is to provide instruction and information for NBGSL base umpires.
- Provide information on what is expected from a NBGSL umpire.
- Provide a reference to positioning A, B and C and when to be in those situations.

Dress Code:

- Umpires will be provided with a NBGSL Umpire Shirt that they will keep for the season and keep clean and wear to the games. This shirt will be returned to the league after the season.
- Umpires must wear pants, either black pants or leggings or jeans are acceptable. Please no shorts.
- The NBGSL umpire shirt must be worn on the outer layer. If it is going to be cold, wear long sleeves or a sweatshirt underneath your NBGSL shirt.
- Please wear closed toe shoes. You need to be able to move quickly and any kind of sandals or slip on shoes are not allowed.

Games:

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled game time.
- In each shed there is a NBGSL Binder with a copy of the rules and there should be a clicker in there if you want one.

Base Umpire Positioning:

- A Position:
  - When: No runners are on base.
  - Where: 10-15 ft behind first base just in foul territory. See Diagram 1.
  - Position A Video
- B Position:
  - When: Runner on first base only.
  - Where: 10-12ft behind the baseline, behind the 2nd baseman. See Diagram 1
  - Position B Video
- C Position:
  - When: All other runner combinations
  - Where: 10-12ft behind the baseline, behind the Short Stop (SS). See Diagram 1
  - Position C Video



Base Umpire Responsibilities:

- All plays at 1st and 2nd base
- First play in the infield by an infielder at 1st, 2nd, 3rd base.
- The batter runner at 3rd base
- Make sure to know whether it is a force play or a tag play.
